### ROLE PURPOSE

In the Early Years, our Inclusive Education teacher will partner with Reception to Year 3 classroom educators and Student Support Officers (SSO) to provide leadership, clarity and consistency in relation to planning, modifications, adjustments and interventions for students with complex learning profiles and needs. They will have experience in resourcing and equipping educators with the skills and knowledge to plan for, and make, appropriate adjustments and modifications for a variety of learners. They will help implement, support and review additional programs, interventions and high-quality differentiated learning opportunities, tasks, assessments and rubrics to support students with their learning and growth. Through the analysis of data, the Inclusive Education teacher will work with, and lead SSOs to work with, identified students in small group, and one-on-one settings, providing targeted literacy and numeracy support. They will work as part of a team, led by our Director of Teaching and Learning and the Inclusive Education Coordinator, to ensure all policies, procedures and processes are consistent across the school and are aligned with the relevant legislation and guidelines.
