SCHOOL

Enrolment at the ELC can be the beginning of a long-term educational journey at HILLS, which may continue right through to Year 12.

ENROLMENT

- Children can start from 3.5 years of age.
- Enrolments align with school term intakes, depending on availability.
- Parents are encouraged to meet with the ELC Director to discuss their child's individual needs before starting.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- The ELC is open for 50 weeks of the year, closing for 2 weeks over Christmas New Year.
- A minimum of two full days per week is recommended for your child's learning and care consistency.
- A late pick-up fee of \$15 applies for every 15-minute block (or part of) after 6:00pm.

CHILD CARE SUBSIDY (CCS)

- HILLS ELC is an approved child care provider.
- Most families are eligible for Child Care Subsidy (CCS), which reduces daily fees.

FOR CASUAL CARE BOOKINGS

- Term time.
- Bookings must be made at least 48 hours in advance.

 - Term 3 onwards: elc@hccs.sa.edu.au
- Include in your email:
 - The date care is required.
 - Whether you need Sunrise or Sunset Care.
 - The estimated drop-off or pick-up time.
- A \$15 admin fee applies to casual session bookings made with less than 48 hours notice.

- Vacation Care requires separate bookings from term-time care.
